

Harton 10 churches circular cycle ride

The route is just over 20 miles, mostly on minor roads or cycle tracks but please take care on the two short sections that involve crossing the A64 (marked in red). The route description uses Gate Helmsley as start-point, but you can join at any point, and go in either direction. Using the minor road from Bossall to Sand Hutton (past Mount Pleasant and Kissthorn Farms), you can just include the five most southerly churches and so avoid the steep sections leading to Howsham, Crambe and Whitwell. *Enjoy your visit to these lovely church buildings – they are all open during the day. Some provide drinks. Only Sand Hutton has a toilet.*
